'Gold' Open Access

 Article freely available from publisher website

'Full' Open Access

 Whole journal is published Open Access

'Hybrid' Open Access

Article level Open
 Access option in
 subscription journals

'Delayed' Open Access

 Articles made freely available to nonsubscribers after a certain period, usually 12 or 24 months

Author Payment

 Author/funder/institution pays for publishing

Sponsored

 Journal sponsored by a non-profit institution or organization


'Green' Open Access

 Self-archiving of author manuscript on author website, institutional or subject-based repositories

A history of Open Access








Open Access market growth


